

Guidelines for the preparation of ORAL and POSTER presentations:

ORAL presentations:

Each oral presentation will have a 15 min time slot total. This will include 10 min to present and 5 min for questions from the audience. Please keep strictly to this time limit – we have quite a busy schedule planned and multiple sessions per day. It is therefore paramount to keep to your time to allow audience members to switch from one session to another.

Your presentation should be in the form of ppt or pptx. You will need to hand over your presentations on a USB Stick labelled with your name to one of our computer technicians in/before the session ideally the day before or at least one Session prior to the session you are presenting in OR definitely the day before your talk if you have your talk in the morning session.

If you are presenting in the first session of Tuesday, 6th of September 2022, please make sure to hand over your presentation to the technician before the plenary talk OR at the icebreaker.

POSTER session

This year's poster presentation will be guided. That means, that you will have to be next to your poster at the time of your poster presentation according to the program and the chair of the session will move through the posters with the audience. You will be required to present your poster for 2 minutes, once it is your turn, then there will be 1 min for questions and 1 min to move to the next poster. The poster presentation is oral only with no equipment. The organizing committee has chosen to try this version to ensure maximum exposure to all posters and participants.

The poster space allocated is 1189 mm high x 841 mm wide. (Size DIN A0, NOT horizontal format). Please be at your posters at the indicated times in the program. Put up your posters Tuesday morning (6th of September 2022), if the program indicates that you will be having your poster presentation on Tuesday after lunch. If you are presenting on Wednesday, please put up your poster on Wednesday morning. Please remove your poster after the poster session, as there is limited space available for all the posters.

We are looking forward to welcoming you in Basel and to hear and read about your scientific work.
